



Jesus anointed at Bethany (Mark 14:1-11)

- 1. Use a Bible dictionary to find out what happened at the Passover/Feast of Unleavened Bread.
 - Was there anything special about the lamb?
 - When was the lamb killed?
 - How does all of this relate to what was happening to Jesus at that time?
- 2. A woman poured perfume on Jesus' head. Why did she do this?
- 3. Using your cross references, see if those who complained about the waste of perfume were genuine in their complaints.
- 4. Jesus said that what the woman had done would be told in memory of her. Did this happen?
- 5. Why did Judas wish to betray Jesus?

The Lord's supper (Mark 14:12-26)

- 6. Find an Old Testament prophecy that shows that it was significant that the betrayer ate with Jesus. (Hint: John 13 quotes this scripture)
- 7. At the Last Supper (or Lord's supper) what did Jesus share with the twelve disciples?

Jesus predicts Peter's denial (Mark 14:27-31)

- 10. Jesus predicted Peter's denial of him. Did it happen? Give a reference.
- 11. Have you ever been determined to stand up for Jesus, even when it is an unpopular thing to do, and then failed? How did you feel?

Gethsemane (Mark 14:32–42)

- 12. Find Gethsemane on a map of Jerusalem.
- 13. Why did Jesus want to pray at that time?

Jesus arrested (Mark 14:43–52)

- 14. Why did Judas arrange to kiss Jesus? Didn't those arresting him know who Jesus was?
- 15. At this difficult time, Jesus was able to think of others above himself. Use cross references to find out what happened to the servant with his ear cut off.
- 16. Jesus said "the scriptures must be fulfilled". Which scriptures was he referring to?

Before the Sanhedrin (Mark 14:53–65)

- 17. Use a Bible dictionary to find out what the Sanhedrin was.
- 18. Why did the chief priests, elders and teachers want to put Jesus to death?
- 19. Jesus did not defend himself.
 - What Old Testament prophet predicted this?
 - Are you able to remain silent when people speak against you?
- 20. Finally Jesus answered the high priest's question.
 - Why did he answer this question?
 - Why did he give more information than they had asked?
 - Why did the high priest say this was blasphemy? Was it?

Peter disowns Jesus (Mark 14:66–72)

- 21. List the three responses of Peter when he was recognized as Jesus' disciple:

- 22. When the cock crowed, Peter realized he had betrayed Jesus.
 - What was Peter's reaction?
 - Would God be pleased with this reaction?
 - What is our reaction when we realize we have done wrong?
