

Bible Reading Group

The gospel of Mark Chapter 15

Jesus before Pilate (Mark 15:1-15)

- 1. Why did the Sanhedrin turn Jesus over to Pilate? (Hint: see John 18:31–32)
- 2. Why did Pilate ask if Jesus was the king of the Jews?
- 3. Why did Jesus answer this question of Pilate, but not the questions of the chief priests?
- 4. Pilate agreed to release Barabbas rather than Jesus, even though he thought Jesus was innocent.
 - Why did he give in to the demands of the crowd?
 - Use cross references to find how Pilate kept his conscience clear when condemning an innocent man.

The soldiers mock Jesus (Mark 15:16-20)

- 5. Why would the soldiers want to mock Jesus so much?
- 6. Were the soldiers genuine when they worshipped this king of the Jews?

The crucifixion (Mark 15:21-32)

- 7. Why was Simon forced to carry Jesus' cross?
- 8. Use a Bible dictionary to find out where Jesus was crucified and why it was called Golgotha (the place of the skull)?
- 9. What was the purpose of offering wine mixed with myrrh to Jesus?
- 10. The soldiers divided up Jesus' clothes and cast lots for them.
 - Why did they cast lots for them?
 - Find an Old Testament prophecy that predicted this.
- 11. At what time of day is the third hour?
- 12. Who put the written notice on the cross?
- 13. How would Jesus feel when he was mocked, though he knew he could come down from the cross?

The death of Jesus (Mark 15:33-41)

- 14. What time is the sixth hour? The ninth hour?
- 15. Jesus cried out "my God, my God, why have you forsaken me".
 - · What language did he say this in?
 - · Why is it left in its original language in our English Bible?
 - Find the Old Testament prophecy about this.
 - Why did some people think he was calling Elijah?
 - Why did someone bring him wine vinegar at this time?
- 16. The curtain of the temple was torn in two from top to bottom.
 - What was the significance of the tearing?
 - Was it significant that it was from top to bottom, not bottom to top?
- 17. What convinced the centurion that Jesus was the son of God?
- 18. List the watching women. Find out who they were. (it may help to check cross references)

The burial of Jesus (Mark 15:42-47)

- 19. Use a Bible dictionary to find out what the "Preparation Day" was.
- 20. Joseph of Arimathea asked for the body of Jesus, so he could bury him.
 - Find out all you can about this man.
 - · Did others in the Council know about his faith?
 - Do you think this was a courageous and faithful act? Why?
- 21. Why was Pilate surprised to hear that Jesus was already dead?
- 22. Pilate gave Joseph the body of Jesus to bury.
 - · Why did he?
 - What usually happened to the bodies of crucified people?
