The very first book printed was the Bible at Mentz in Germany, by Johannes Guttenberg, who was the inventor of the 'movable type' printing press. By 1455 he had printed the Bible in Latin, the first edition being 180 copies - the first mass-produced book.

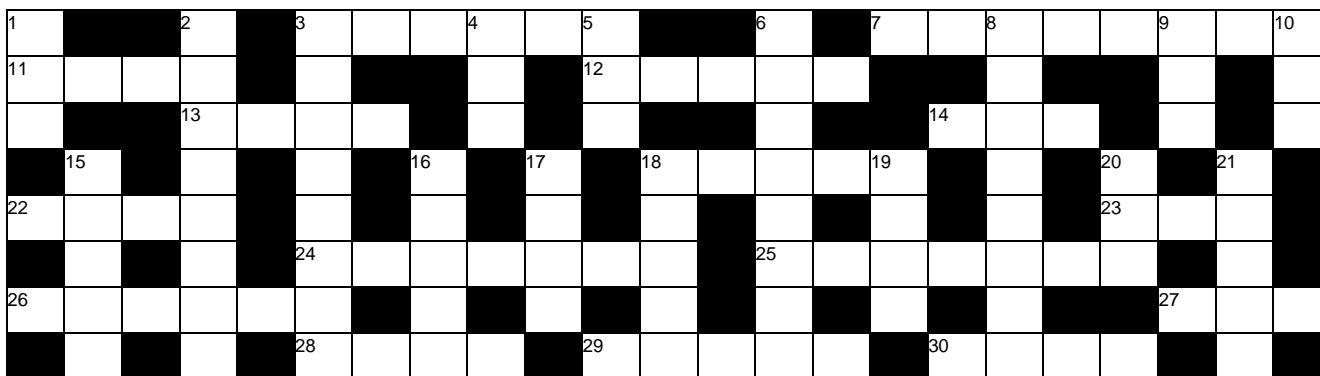
